2019 RULES



1. For any age horse of allbreeds.
2. For the purpose of PRO-AM clarification, a \$50,000 Amateur for this class is anyone who is designated through the NCHA to be eligible and holds a \$50,000 Amateur status (eligibility) in either weekend or limited aged event classes. (The question of eligibility is the sole responsibility of the individual showing, anyone found not to be eligible will forfeit any and all entry fees, monies and awards.)
3. **\$2,500 added purse.**
4. **Entries Due Sunday May 12th, 2019** *Includes \$250 Entry Fee, \$250 Cattle Charge, \$57 OF Fees (*OF – Office Fee Breakdown: OCHA approval \$10.00, Arena Fee \$10.00, Office Fee \$29.00, Video \$7.00, NCHA Dir. fee \$1.00
5. PRO-AM will be held at May show in Madras and June show in Burns (both have \$2,500 added)
6. Entries are taken and processed per OCHA Aged Event Entry Rules. All owners and riders must be current OCHA/NCHA members to compete.
7. The OCHA PRO-AM Cutting will consist of 2 go – rounds and a finals. Pro (trainer) must show the horse in the 1st go – round. Owner (Amateur) must show in the 2nd go – round. Scratched entries from the 1st go – round shall not advance to the second go – round. The top scoring 25% of the combined go rounds (with a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 12) will advance to the finals. The Amateur from the 2nd go – round must show the horse in the finals.
8. Amateurs must own their own horse and may show only one horse. Pro (trainers) may show an unlimited number of horses.
9. Each go-round will pay \$500 added money plus 33% of the jackpotted monies per 1st and 2nd go. Places will be according to NCHA weekend payouts. The remaining jackpot monies of 34% plus the remaining \$1,500 will be awarded to the finals purse paying down 5 spots.
10. Three (3) head of Fresh cattle will be used in the go – rounds and three (3) head fresh cattle in the finals.
11. If there are any ties for the championship of an OCHA event, there will be a work off for the title and awards. The purse for the ties will be combined and will be distributed 50/50 based on the results of the work off.
12. The Oregon CHA Executive Committee reserves the right should it be deemed necessary, to make any changes or alterations to the above rules.
13. Awards for Champion and Reserve Champion.
